Anti Ragging Campaign

Notification to Students

Prohibition of Ragging

- 1. Ragging means display of disorderly conduct, doing of any act, which cause or is likely to cause physical or psychological harm for raised apprehension or fear or shame for embarrassment to student in and educational institute and include:
- I) Teasing, abusing, threatening for playing practical jocks on or causing hurt to student or
- II) Asking a student to do any act or perform something with the student will not in the ordinary course, willingly do.
- 2. The student for his or her parents or guardian or the teachers of an educational institute can complaint to the head of the institute in writing.
- 3. Immediate disciplinary action will be taken against students involved in ragging.
- 4. Any student who is proved to be guilty in ragging will face inquiry in the police station within the jurisdiction of the institute.
- 5. Whoever directly or indirectly committee, participate in, abets of profacate ragging within or outside of an educational institution, shall, on conviction, be punished with imprisonment for two years and shall also be liable to a fine of rupees ten thousand (10,000/-) or shall be suspended or dismissed from medical college.

Such students will not be admitted in any other educational institution for period of five years from the date of order of such dismissal.
